Abstract:

The goals of this study were:

- to collect informations about social structure and about mobility in Czechoslovakia
- to investigate opinions and attitudes about family values, social differences, social level an living standards and work and science-technical improvement.

Population:

The sample is representative for the Czechoslovak population of age 15 and older.

Units of Observation: individual

Sample Size: Individual interviews: n=18,829
Attitude survey: n= 3,543

Note: The datafile from attitude survey is available only without variable and value labels.

Dimension of the Data Set: 18,829 cases and 784 variables from individual interviews

Sampling Procedures: Three sampling steps (residence - household - individual) from the file originally created for the statistical survey of income (1981). In such a way 21,000 respondents were randomly selected from the original file of 120,000 cases and 200,000 households.

Method of Data Collection: Standardized individual interviews, standardized questionnaire (individuals and attitudes); standardized mail-sent questionnaire (organizations).
