## 1. Sample

The survey was based on the representative sample $(18,829$ respondents) of the Czechoslovak population of age $15+$ which was extracted in three sampling steps (residence - household - individual) from the file originally created for the statistical survey of income (1981). In such a way 21,000 respondents were randomly selected from the original file of 120,000 cases and 200,000 households.
