WHEN WAS THE DATA COLLECTED:

RESEARCH ORGANIZATION:

Research was headed by CVVM research team of the Sociological Institute of the Academy of Sciences as a part of “Our Society 2017” research. Data collection was conducted by trained interviews of the interview network of Public Opinion Research Center.

Parameters of research:

A total number of 1045 respondents of 15 years and older representing the population of the Czech Republic were questioned. Characteristics of the quota sampling were gender, age and education. Territorial representability of the data is maintained by the construction on the interviewer network itself, where the controlled characteristics are the size of the place of residence and regions (old regions).

Parameters of the data set correspond with the structure of the population of the Czech Republic as for the structure of the sociodemographic characteristics (gender, education, age) and also as for the area. Overall, it can be claimed the sample is representative because its composition is in accordance with the population of the Czech Republic (with the tolerance of minimal deviation).

In the ground data collection, a total number of 259 interviewers took part in. They evaluated the questioning situation very well. Due to high quality of filled in questionnaires, all conducted interviews were integrated.

The data set evinces high level of representability and it was not weighted.

MODE OF THE DATA COLLECTION:

Standardized interview. Data collection was conducted by trained interviews of the interview network of Public Opinion Research Center.

Weighting:

Dataset is not weighted.
