- 3 persons working or studying away from home over a long period, irrespective of the duration of absence, having no private address elsewhere and maintaining close relations with the surveyed household;**
- 4 persons staying in a hospital or another institution for a long period, if staying away for less than 6 months and having close financial relations with the household.**
